Air quality and domestic BB in the Po Basin



Air quality report 2019, EEA





- high density of population and productive activities
 ⇒ high pollutant emissions
- unfavourable morphology and meteorology
 ⇒ high pollutant concentrations (NO₂, PM, O₃)

Primary emissions from domestic heating:

• PM10: 56% (mostly BB)

The LIFE PREPAIR Integrated Project



- PREPAIR: Po Regions Engaged to Policies of AIR
- 18 partners (Regions + Environmental Agencies + Municipalities)
- LIFE Programme for Environment / Integrated Project
- main objective: supporting the full and coordinated implementation of <u>Air Quality Plans</u> and <u>Po Basin Agreement measures</u> on supraregional territorial scale for effective air pollution reduction



total budget: 16.805.939 € EU co-financing: 9.974.624 € complementary funds: > 850 M€



duration: 7 years (01.02.2017-31.01.2024) time plan: 3 phases (@phase 2)















Training of domestic biomass system technicians



LIFE PREPAIR - Action C6: "Technical and specialist training for installers and designers of domestic biomass systems"

Coordinating beneficiary: Autonomous Province of Trento - APPA

Target: designers, installers and maintenance technicians of biomass heating systems

Objectives:

- qualification of technical competencies of professionals/technicians for low-emission domestic BB and awareness of impacts on air quality and human health
- reinforcement of their role in promoting sustainable domestic BB among citizens

Expected results:

- realization of a common training format (1 workshop + 4 modules / 4+64 h)
- 80 technicians trained for each partner Region (2018-2022)

Current implementation status:

- 2 course editions @ Province of Trento
- 2 course editions @ Veneto Region
- 1 course edition @ Friuli Venezia Giulia
- strong interest among stakeholders (>135 participants to 1st initial workshop @ Trento)

 \Rightarrow 42+16 participants

 \Rightarrow 12+8 participants













Promotion of chimney sweep professional role

LIFE PREPAIR - Action C7: "Enhancement of the role of the 'qualified chimney sweep' for control and mantainance of biomass domestic systems"

Coordinating beneficiary: Autonomous Province of Trento - APPA

Target: chimney sweeps (not yet/already working)

Objectives:

- definition of chimney sweeps demand/supply, regulatory framework, good practices
- definition of 'qualified chimney sweep' professional profile, training courses and registry
- promotion of professional chimney cleaning and awareness raising (health & safety)

Expected results:

- realization of a comprehensive survey and definition of a qualification professional profile
- common training format and courses in each partner Region (2019/22)
- establishment of regional public registries of 'qualified chimney sweeps'
- legislative proposal for 'qualified chimney sweep' figure recognition

Current implementation status:

- survey, qualification profile and training format closed
- strong interest among stakeholders and close cooperation

LIFE PREPAIR - Action E3: "Communication on the use of biomass"

Coordinating beneficiary: Lombardy Region

Target: citizens of Po Basin Regions

Objective:

• implementation of a common communication campaign on the impacts of domestic BB on air quality and human health, diffusion of good practices for cleaner and safe residential BB

Expected results:

- preliminary survey on past communication activities
- common communication strategy, tools and materials
- coordinated campaign implementation during wintertimes (2018-2022)

Current implementation status:

- first campaign concluded, second campaign ending in March 2020
- video: 18k+ views on YouTube, 38k+ views on Facebook
- leaflet: 11k printed copies distributed, 4k+ downloads
- brochure: 12k printed copies distributed, 6k+ downloads













Awareness raising on cleaner BB



LIFE PREPAIR - Action E3: "Communication on the use of biomass"



Other activities:

- articles in local magazines, newsletters, institutional websites, scientific-technical journals ...
- public informative events organized in collaboration with Municipalities and local firefighters, forest management bodies, energy agencies: (9 events + 3 more to come / ~ 400 people)
- "educational pills" on BB good practices and PREPAIR materials distribution at trade fairs and exhibitions (5 events / ~ 200 people)
- specific environmental education activities in primary and secondary schools



Observations:

- community engagement is the key to successful communication
- combining health/environment issues with safety issues (roof thatch fires, carbon monoxide poisoning) is a good strategy
- practical demonstrations of fire ignition methods have remarkable success







Conclusions

- <u>LIFE PREPAIR project</u>: provides <u>funding and network</u> to support the coordinated implementation of regional/provincial Air Quality Plans and the reduction of air pollution in the Po basin
- activation of training courses for designers, installers and maintainers of domestic biomass systems with the aim of promoting the <u>role of technicians</u> as "first educators of citizens" in spreading cleaner domestic BB
- enhancement of the professional role and activation of training courses for "qualified chimney sweeps" with the aim of promoting the <u>role of chimney sweeps</u> as "first educators of citizens" in spreading cleaner & safer domestic BB
- implementation of a <u>common communication campaign</u> capitalizing on past experiences of partners and engagement of local communities to boost effective dissemination
