National strategy



Work in synergy with regional administrations in order to strengthen their action through:

- Direct support of a financial nature
- Measures in areas that cannot be reached by regional initiatives
- Dialogue with the European commission

State-region working group to select the order of priority of interventions in order to direct incentives to the most problematic sectors. The first sector on which to intervene is agriculture with funding aimed at encouraging the replacement of agricultural equipment, the covering of wastewater storage tanks, the use of advanced means of fertilization, the emergence of chains of valorization of agricultural residues in order to avoid their burning in the open







Agreements MITE-Regions

As of 2017, 10 agreements have been signed with Regions for a total of 13 Regions involved (Po Valley Basin Regions, Campania, Lazio, Liguria, Marche, Puglia, Sicilia, Toscana, Umbria, Provincia autonoma di Bolzano) for a total of 105 million euros). In the recent period, additional resources of 220 million euros (years 2021-2028) have been made available to the Regions for all Regions outside the Po Valley Basin







Turin protocol signed on 4 june 2019 Air quality action plan

On September 23, 2021, the Council of Ministers signed the Understanding to extend the Turin Protocol until 2023, with a mandate to revise it.

- RDP agriculture measures funding
- Micromobility decree

- Creation of annual air quality fund 2.3 billion euros
- Alignment of biomass incentives for civil use






New Agreement MITE-AIEL-Regions

- Quality of fuels
- Manufacturers' Commitments
